VOTER GUIDE

Electronic Conference

At the 2021 District Council, a resolution was adopted that allows the District Council Business meeting to be conducted, in whole or in part, by electronic conference. In 2022, it was the first time qualified registered voters participated in person or remotely. Once again, we will conduct the 2024 business meeting by electronic conference. Please note, reasonable efforts will be made for remote participants to be able to hear the proceedings concurrently, as well as to obtain the attention and recognition of the chair, and to speak to all members—to make motions, raise questions, and participate in the debate. Should unexpected technological problems occur preventing remote participants from engaging in the meeting, it will not require the meeting to be suspended or postponed; or, after adjournment, be grounds to contest or nullify a decision made under such circumstances. (District Bylaws, Article Ten, Section Five: Conduct Business by Electronic Conference)

Voting Procedures for In-person and Remote Participants:

The first electoral ballot will be open from 10am to 10pm, Monday, April 22nd.

- Each eligible voter must register with their unique email address. Two people cannot use the same email address if they both wish to vote.
- At 10am, Monday, April 22nd, each eligible voter will receive an email with a link to cast their ballot. Simply click on the link.
- The ballot will remain open until 10pm.

Subsequent voting (if needed) during the business session, Tuesday, April 23rd.

- All voters must register a voting device with cellular service at the time of registration. This device can be a cell phone or tablet. During the live business meeting, instructions will be given to log into the voting platform to participate in any additional elections or secret ballot votes that may need to be conducted during business.

District Bylaws: Article Three—Qualifications, Nominations, Elections and Removal of Officers

Section Two: Nominations of Officers

A. Nomination of District Officials and General Council Presbyters

1. Nomination of District Superintendent

All candidates for District Superintendent shall be nominated by secret ballot of the membership at a meeting of the membership of the District Council in session. The Tellers Committee shall tally the nominations and provide the chairman with a list of all names which received six or more nominations ordered by decreasing number of votes along with the number of nomination

Nominating ballot will be cast Monday, April 22nd at 10 AM and will remain open until 10 PM.

Nomination for District Superintendent

The nomination ballot is a blank write-in ballot. Please type in First and Last Name.

Candidates must be:

- At least 25 years of age
- Ordained for at least two full years
- Member of this District for at least one full year

A list of qualified candidates will be available to you when you open your ballot on the Monday, April 22nd.

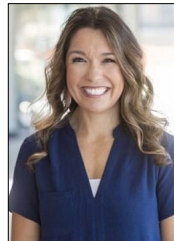

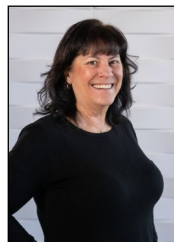

RESOLUTION #1

CPA FINANCIAL REVIEW

Resolution to Amend by Strikeout / Insertion

BYLAWS, ARTICLE ELEVEN, SECTION FIVE, PARAGRAPH A.

Needing a Two-Thirds Majority Vote

WHEREAS, legal and institutional changes have substantially altered the audit industry, creating substantial work and liability to the CPA firm, and consequently, many CPA firms no longer provide full audit services; *and*

WHEREAS, these changes also make a full financial audit exceedingly expensive, costing the District approximately \$50,000 per year; *and*

WHEREAS, a full financial audit does not address the typical questions that our members are asking, and a financial review is deemed sufficient and is far less expensive; *and*

WHEREAS, it would be beneficial for the District Council to amend its bylaws to eliminate the full audit requirement and allow for an annual financial review; *therefore, be it*

RESOLVED, that District Council Bylaws, Article Eleven, Section Five, Paragraph A. be amended by ~~strikeout~~ and ~~insertion~~ as follows:

ARTICLE ELEVEN - FINANCES

Section Five: Audits

A. Regular Audits

~~1. The financial records of this District Council shall be audited~~ reviewed by a certified public accountant at the close of every fiscal year ~~evenly divisible by three~~, with the accountant's report to be submitted at a date just prior to District Council Convention. The auditor shall provide a certificate of ~~audit~~ review, in duplicate, with one copy to be retained by the District Treasurer and the other to be placed and retained in the book of records of this District Council. ~~On the other two years a financial review by a certified public accountant shall be substituted for the full audit.~~

~~2. The year following a full financial audit, the District shall employ a law firm to perform a legal audit, investigating whether the District is in compliance with all relevant laws and with standard practices.~~

~~3. The year following a legal audit, the District shall employ a law firm to perform a liability audit, investigating whether the District has sufficient coverage and whether any District policies or practices expose the District to needless risk.~~

B. Special Audits

In event of a change of Treasurer, the Executive Presbytery may choose to request a full financial audit.

MINISTERIAL TITHE

Proposed Resolution to Retain

BYLAWS, ARTICLE ELEVEN, SECTION ONE

Needing Majority Vote

WHEREAS, the Bylaws call for an annual review of the minister’s contribution schedule allowing for its adjustment by increase or decrease as determined by applying the California cost of living index, and that the recommended changes be presented for ratification in the form of a resolution to the membership at District Council; *and*

WHEREAS, the Executive Presbytery has become aware that the District Council will be facing substantial financial challenges in the future which cannot be resolved by the typical “tithe increase” or “good management”, *and*

WHEREAS, the Executive Presbytery has decided to initiate discussions with the members regarding the District’s financial and service model, *and*

WHEREAS, it would be beneficial and easier to have these discussions without the apprehension that a “tithe increase” often causes, *therefore, be it*

RESOLVED, that this District Council in session approve there be no change to the minister's tithe contribution schedule for the year 2024; *and, be it further*

RESOLVED, that we express great thanks to God for His blessing to our District and seek the Lord’s help for His direction in these discussions.
